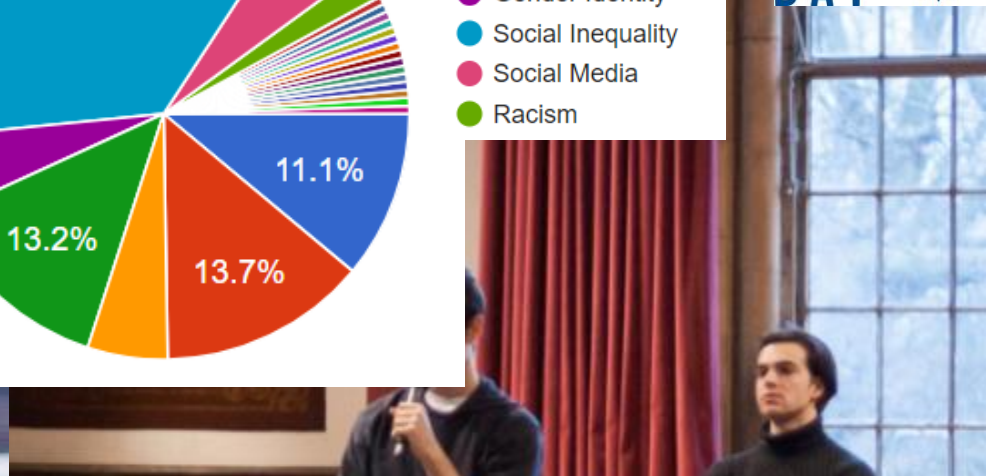
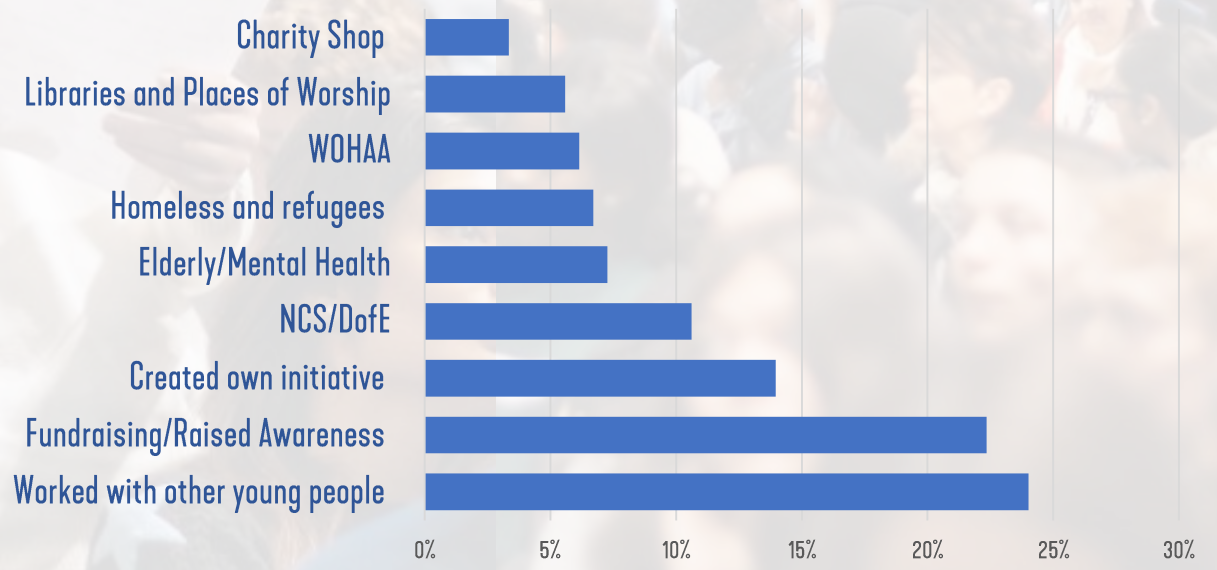


# YOUTH ENGAGEMENT

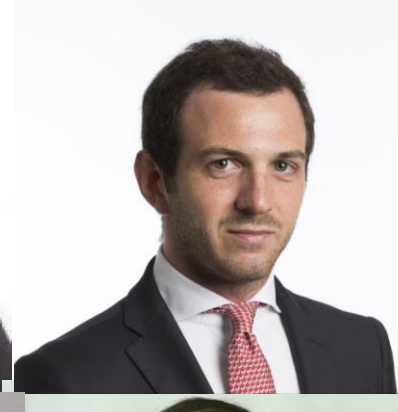
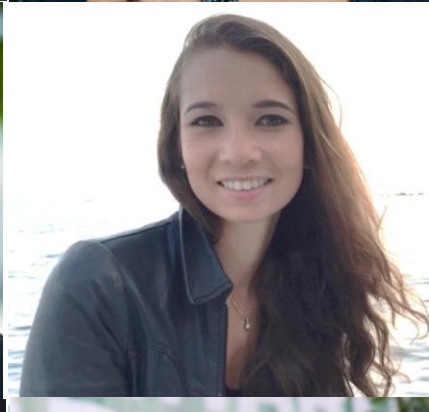
